

Christmas Wreaths

Although the tradition of the wreath can be traced back to the Romans, it was a tradition the Victorians embraced and made their own. Victorian wreaths were often elaborate and made with all types of evergreen foliage, such as holly, ivy and yew. To decorate they would use fruit, such as apples and oranges; pine cones; holly berries; and chestnuts. In addition, they would sometimes include floral, ribbon or lacy designs common in Victorian decorating and were hung on the door as a sign of greeting.
