Victorian Paper Christmas Ornaments

People in the Victorian era often decorated their Christmas trees with paper ornaments such as paper fans. Try making your own paper fan at home by following the instructions below:

You will need:

- Gold paper or any colour you would like to use.
- Paper doily
- Ribbon

Step 1:

Cut your doily in half and glue it along the bottom half of you sheet of coloured paper.

Step 2:

When the glue is dry, fold your piece of paper section by section length wise into an accordion shape.

Step 3:

Pinch the bottom of the folded paper and tie it off at the bottom with a ribbon to create the fan shape.

Step 4:

To hang the ornament on your tree, punch a small hole at the top of the fan to thread a ribbon through which can be tied and the ornament hung on your tree!
