

Frosty the Snowman

In 1950, a new holiday song was introduced that told the tale of an inanimate snowman that came to life to spread good cheer. Written by Steve Nelson and Jack Rollins, and performed by Gene Autry, "Frosty the Snowman" soon became an international hit. The song was quickly covered by many artists including Jimmy Durante, Nat King Cole, Perry Como, and Guy Lombardo.

In 1969, the beloved television special premiered with the voices of Jimmy Durante, as the narrator; Billy De Wolfe as Professor Hinkle; and Jackie Vernon as Frosty. The story also includes a girl named Karen, who befriends Frosty, and a pet rabbit named Hocus.

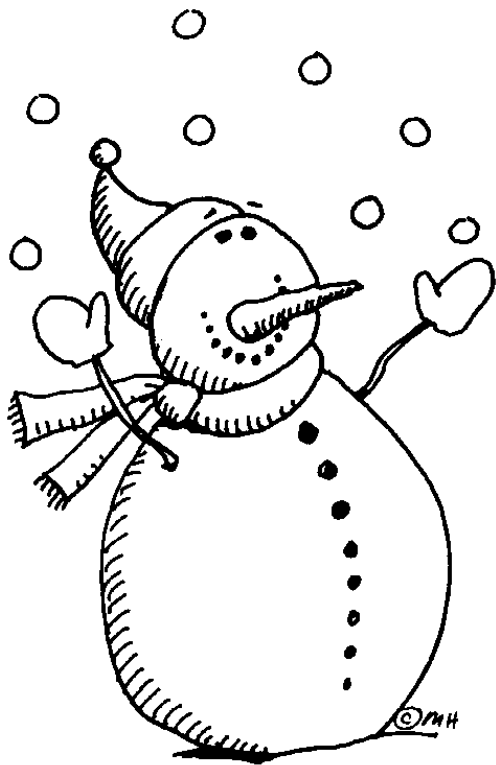
