
Transferring Video to a Storage Device


You can now transfer your video file to a USB device <u>or</u> burn to a DVD. Follow these steps to transfer your video file.

Transferring to a USB Device


- **Step 1:** Insert USB into the computer tower
- Step 2: Autoplay popup window will display. Choose "open folder to view files using Windows Explorer"



Step 3: On the desktop, find your video file. Right click and select "Send to" and select your USB from the list.



Step 4: Once your file is finished transferring over, you will see it in your list of files on the USB drive. You can now eject your USB device.




<u>Tip</u>: Remember to delete your video file from the desktop once you are finished!

Transferring Video to a Storage Device

Transferring to a Blank DVD


- Step 1: Insert a blank DVD into the disc drive on the computer tower (DVDs are available to purchase from our circulation desk)
- 2 Step 2: After a few moments, a popup will display. Choose "Burn files to disc using Windows Explorer"



Step 3: Give your disc a name and choose the way you want to save your files.



Step 4: From the desktop, drag and drop your video file to the middle column in the DVD popup window.



Step 5: Click "burn to disc" then click "next". Your DVD may take several minutes to burn. When your DVD is finished, the disc will pop out. Please take your disc.
