William Raymond Kemp lived at 118 Mutual Street, Ingersoll from 1947 until 2002 when he moved to St. Thomas. After attending school in Waterford, Ontario, Bill started working at William Stone Sons (later CIL) in Ingersoll. Bill enlisted in the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps, in London, in 1942. After training in Listowel, Red Deer, Alberta and England, he saw extensive service in Sicily, Italy, France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. His medals include: the 1939-45 Star, the Italy Star, the France and Germany Star, the Defence Medal, the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and the War Medal. While in Holland, Bill met and married Elly. They will celebrate their 60th anniversary on January 22, 2006. An avid Toronto Blue Jays fan, Bill's other interests include golfing, five pin bowling, curling. Bill and Elly have three children: AnneMarie Rule, married to Ashley, and living in Springfield, Ontario; Barry Kemp, married to Donna and living in Lincoln, New Brunswick; and Sue Jillard, married to Lyle, and living in St. Thomas.
