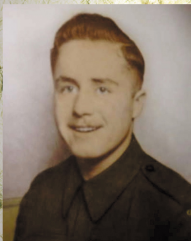

Pte. Gordon Locky **Killed In Action**

Mrs. Bertha Locky, Tunis street, this week received word that her son, Private Gordon John Ross Locky, has been officially reported killed in action on December ninth. The telegram which was received from the Director of Records, stated that further information would follow, when received. Pte. Locky has been overseas for three years.

Private Gordon John Ross Locky was a son of Alfred and Bertha Muriel Locky, of Ingersoll, Ontario.

Gordon enlisted in the First Hussars soon after the war began, in September 1939.

Private Gordon John Ross Locky was reported killed in action December 9, 1943, as part of the Allied plan to capture Rome. He rests in MORO RIVER CANADIAN WAR CEMETERY, Italy.
