Private James Vance Neill was a son of William and Janet Neill husband of Edith Neill, of Ingersoll, Ontario. Born in Mochrum, Scotland.

James was a foreman at the Noxon Manufacturing Company was trained as a carpenter. He married Emma Huckle in 1912. He enlisted in Ingersoll in 1916 with the 168th Battallon. Oxford Riles.
