Warrant Officer Class II Brock Laverne Owen was a son of Horace Roy and Lillian M. Owen, of Ingersoll.

Brock attended school in Ingersoll and later worked as a branch officer for the London Free Press in Stratford. He enlisted with the Royal Canadian Air Force in 1941.

Warrant Officer Class II Brock Laverne Owen was killed in action, July 4, 1943. He rests at HEVERLEE WAR CEMETERY, Belgium.
