INGERSOLL FLYER KILLED.

INGERSOLL, July 17.—Flight Lieut. Lawrence Wait, son of Mrs. Walter Wait, of this town, was accidentally killed in England yesterday, according to a cablegram received to-day. Flight Lieut. Wait had only been in England a few weeks. Before enlisting he was employed in the office of the Morrow Company. He was widely known in town and an active member of the B. Y. P. U., and the Four Square Class of the Baptist Church.

Second Lieutenant Lawrence Phelps
Waite was the eldest son of Ralls Waite
and Bessie Phelps Waite, of Ingersoll,
Ontario.

Lawrence attended school in Ingersoll and was employed at the John Morrow Company as a clerk. He enlisted in the Royal Air Force.

Waite was tragically killed as the result of
an accident in England. He rests at
