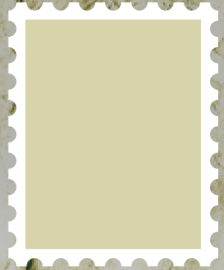

Lance Corporal Harry George Wright was a son of Henry Edward George Wright and Mary Ann Tonks Wright, of Charles St. East, Ingersoll, Ontario.

Harry was born in Walthamstow, Essex, United Kingdom and emigrated to Ingersoll with his parents. He worked in Ingersoll as a mechanic and joined the 168th Battalion in 1916.

Lance Corporal Harry George Wright was killed in action at Ypres, Belgium. He rests at MENIN GATE (YPRES) MEMORIAL, Belgium.
