Letter From Mayor English

Ingersoll, July 17th, 1924

Dear Friends :

There are perhaps, no words in the English Language which are so true and which express the thought of all of us, so vividly as the words of the homely old song, "There is No Place Like Home." Strong men who have severed the ties of home in their youth have been brought to tears by that lovely song, which has taken them back over the intervening years of struggle to the days when they joined with their parents and their childhood friends in the best days of any life, the days of youth.

Those of us who have remained at home, in Ingersoll have realized that many thousands of girls and boys have left home in the years that are past, and have gone into the busy life of other centres, of Canada and the States. 
These are some of the things which have been done by those of us at home, to carry the Old Town's Honor for you while you have been reflecting honor on Ingersoll by your successes in other fields.

WATERWORKS DEPARTMENT---System installed in 1890 by The Ingersoll Waterworks Co. and purchased by the Municipality in 1912. The system supplies 77 Fire Hydrants and 1417 Domestic and Commercial consumers. An abundant supply of clear, cool, spring water is obtained from a system of springs about three miles from town. A modern chlorinating plant using liquid chlorine gas is maintained to insure the sterility of the water.

ELECTRIC POWER & LIGHT DEPARTMENT ---Power is purchased from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario at 13200 volts and stepped down for local use at the sub-station on Mill Street. Power and Lighting rates are in the lowest schedule in the Province. Over 200 electric ranges are in use in the town, the average bill for cooking and lighting being about \$4.00 per month.

HYDRO SHOP---The Commission also operates the Hydro Shop where the best types of Electric Ranges, Washing Machines and Electrical Appliances of all kinds are sold.

Rates for Water and Electricity will be gladly given to any one interested on application at the Public Utilities building on Thames Street.


