# Letter From Mayor English

Ingersoll, July 17th, 1924

Dear Friends :

There are perhaps, no words in the English Language which are so true and which express the thought of all of us, so vividly as the words of the homely old song, "There is No Place Like Home." Strong men who have severed the ties of home in their youth have been brought to tears by that lovely song, which has taken them back over the intervening years of struggle to the days when they joined with their parents and their childhood friends in the best days of any life, the days of youth.

Those of us who have remained at home, in Ingersoll have realized that many thousands of girls and boys have left home in the years that are past, and have gone into the busy life of other centres, of Canada and the States. We know that the memory of the town which was yours in your youth, still is the most happy memory for you. We look with great pride on the fact that there is no town of the size of Ingersoll which has sent out more of its citizenship, who have made outstanding success, than has the town which you call yours.

We at home, have realized full well that a great responsibility devolved upon us while Ingersoll Boys and Girls have been carrying Ingersoll's Honour, by their success in other fields. And we have all tried very hard to fulfill that responsibility in such a way that you might be proud to say that "Ingersoll Is Your Home Town." We have made your old Town, one of the foremost manufacturing centres of the Dominion, with our twenty-three factories, Ingersoll products go into every centre of Canada, and, are the standard of quality in the lines they represent. We know that you will want to view yourself, the marked advance in manufacturing which has been made since you left. And we have, therefore, arranged a manufacturing exhibit of Ingersoll products for you and we say with modesty that we believe the exhibit will be looked upon as the finest manufacturing exhibit that has ever been arranged by any town in Canada.

Many of you remember, the macadam roads on Thames Street with the cobblestone curbs, this was considered a good road in the days when you were home, but we have kept in line with advancing times and your old home town is to-day, known all over Canada as the best paved town of its size. And we know you will join with us in the pride we feel because of the wonderful way the Old Town responded to our country's call. Do you also know that your old home town led Canada in the Victory Loan campaigns?

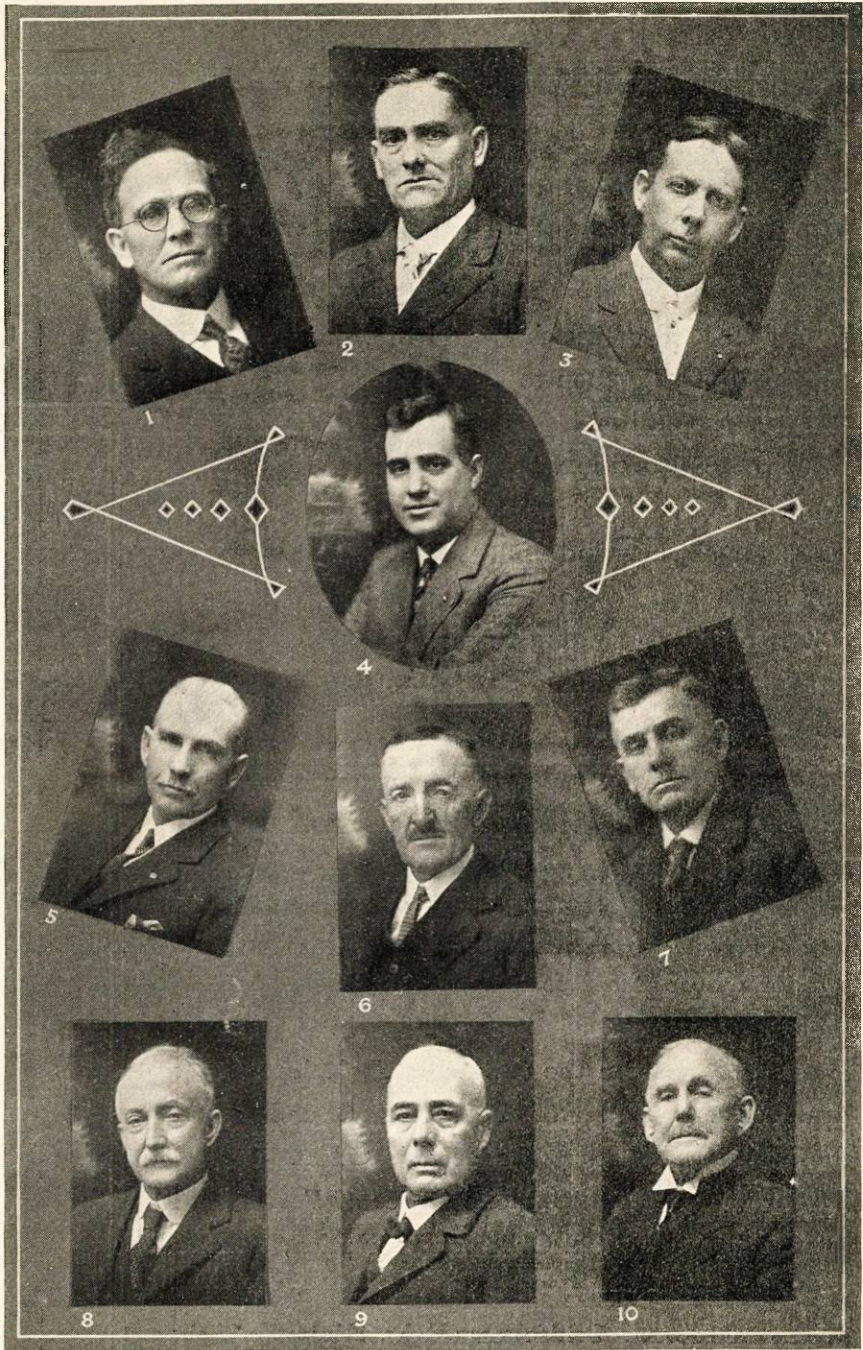
These are some of the things which have been done by those of us at home, to carry the Old Town's Honor for you while you have been reflecting honor on Ingersoll by your successes in other fields.

And we want you to come back, we want to see you all again and live over again the scenes of by-gone days. We promise you that you will own the town while you are here and we know that it is the desire of every citizen of your Old Home Town that everything be done to make your visit so enjoyable, and to make our welcome to you so warm that you will always be glad to throw off the busy days which are yours and come back carefree to live again in the scenes of your childhood and to join once again with us in the closest bonds of friendship.

**WATERWORKS DEPARTMENT**---System installed in 1890 by The Ingersoll Waterworks Co. and purchased by the Municipality in 1912. The system supplies 77 Fire Hydrants and 1417 Domestic and Commercial consumers. An abundant supply of clear, cool, spring water is obtained from a system of springs about three miles from town. A modern chlorinating plant using liquid chlorine gas is maintained to insure the sterility of the water.

**ELECTRIC POWER & LIGHT DEPARTMENT**  
---Power is purchased from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario at 13200 volts and stepped down for local use at the sub-station on Mill Street. Power and Lighting rates are in the lowest schedule in the Province. Over 200 electric ranges are in use in the town, the average bill for cooking and lighting being about \$4.00 per month.

**HYDRO SHOP**---The Commission also operates the Hydro Shop where the best types of Electric Ranges, Washing Machines and Electrical Appliances of all kinds are sold.

Rates for Water and Electricity will be gladly given to any one interested on application at the Public Utilities building on Thames Street.

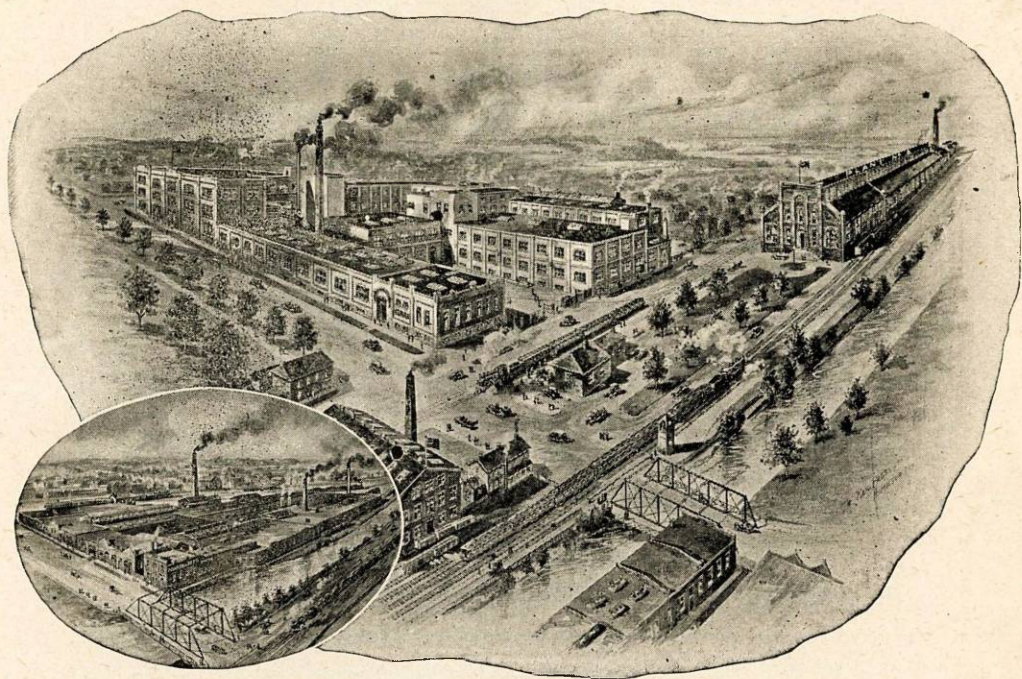

FOR WEDNESDAY NIGHT, AUGUST 13th

**NO. 1—AERIAL THUNDER BOLTS**—Exploding high in the sky announcing the commencement of the evening's entertainment.

**NO. 2—DISCHARGE OF 3 EXHIBITION BOMBSHELLS**—Eagle's Claws, Poppies and Corn, Golden Skeins.

**NO. 3—NOVEL EXHIBITION BOMBSHELL**—"Aerial Spinners". This is a bombshell that discharges fiery devices that gyrate rapidly as they descend.

**NO. 4—DISCHARGE OF VERY SNAPPY BOMBSHELL**—"The Pom Pom." Surprising and startling in effect. A series of flashes and loud reports.

**NO. 5—PRISMATIC ILLUMINATION**—A Fairyland of Transformation. Produced by Mammoth Flambeau which change color four times, flooding the landscape with Ruby, Emerald, Amber and Diamond Light.

**NO. 6—DISPLAY OF TINTED CRYSTAL ROCKETS**—The nucleus of each star is tinted and is followed by a train of silver dust.

**NO. 7—SHELL OF SHELLS**—A specially fine bombshell. A mammoth shell that contains a number of smaller ones. These are thrown out when the larger shell bursts.

**NO. 8—DISCHARGE OF DAZZLING BOMBSHELLS**—"The Silver Cloud." These three shells follow each other closely giving a profusion of silver stars.

**NO. 9—DISCHARGE OF SHELL OF ROCKETS**—A surprising effect. The great shell bursts and immediately a swarm of rockets, with long tails are seen rushing through the sky.

**NO. 10—Beautiful Lancework device** :—The Set Piece—"WEL-COME." In firework lances of the most vivid colors—each letter three feet in height. Whilst the motto is still burning, a crest line of Exhibition Roman Candles throw up streams of stars of every hue.

**NO. 11—DISCHARGE OF WONDER SHELL**—The Sun and Planets—When the shell bursts, it throws out smaller shells, forming the central sun surrounded by its planets.

Decided tints and great variety of color :—Casket of Diamonds, Casket of Rubies, Casket of Sapphires, Casket of Emeralds, etc.

**NO. 13—SHELL OF FLASHING COMETS**—This beautiful bombshell throws out a bevy of golden comets which commence to descend in graceful lines and then the comet discharges four bright spangling stars.

**NO. 14—ASCENT OF CONFETTI ROCKETS**—Containing stars of every color known to the firework maker. A rich profusion of—Rubies, Amethysts, Amber Tips, Turquoise, Comets, Emeralds, etc.

**NO. 15—GROVE OF JEWELLED PALMS**—A long row of Ground Fireworks, consisting of Extra Large Golden Geysers, throwing up great volumes of spangling fire. Each geyser is surrounded by streams of stars of every pyrotechnic color.

**NO. 16—DISCHARGE OF MONSTER BOMBSHELL**—Beauty of the Orient. This is a star, galaxy, embracing—Turquoise Stars, Vridian Stars, Diamond Stars, Emerald Stars, Garnet Stars.

**NO. 17—FLIGHT OF BEAUTIFUL BOMBSHELLS**—Rising simultaneously and bursting at a great height in a seething mass of emerald green stars.

**NO. 18—DISCHARGE OF BRITISH ADMIRALTY SHELL**—Very bright stars floating on parachutes and finishing with trails of Diamond Dust.

**NO. 19—DISCHARGE OF NEW BOMBSHELL**—“The Coronet” Filled with star gems of many colors and in a wide circle, leaving a central field filled with golden fire.

**NO. 20—BUNCH OF CHRYSANTHEMUM WHEELS**—With Streams of Crimson Roses. This is a bunch of four rapidly rotating wheels that throw off myriads of crystal white petals. From each side of these wheels, streams of rosey stars are thrown in great arches, over the central object. A dazzling and surprising number.

**NO. 21—TRIPLE BURSTING EMPIRE BOMBSHELL**—Exploding on high with three distinct bursts of National colors. 1st burst, Red; 2nd burst, White; 3rd burst, Blue.

**NO. 22—FLIGHT OF SILVER GRAIN ROCKETS**—Each star breaks into silver grains but before breaking show various delicate tints. Violet tints, Emerald tints, Azure tints, Pink tints, Amber tints.

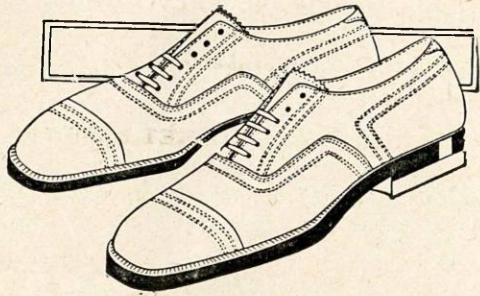
**NO. 24—DISPLAY OF TINTED CRYSTAL ROCKETS**—The nucleus of each star is tinted and is followed by a train of silver dust.
