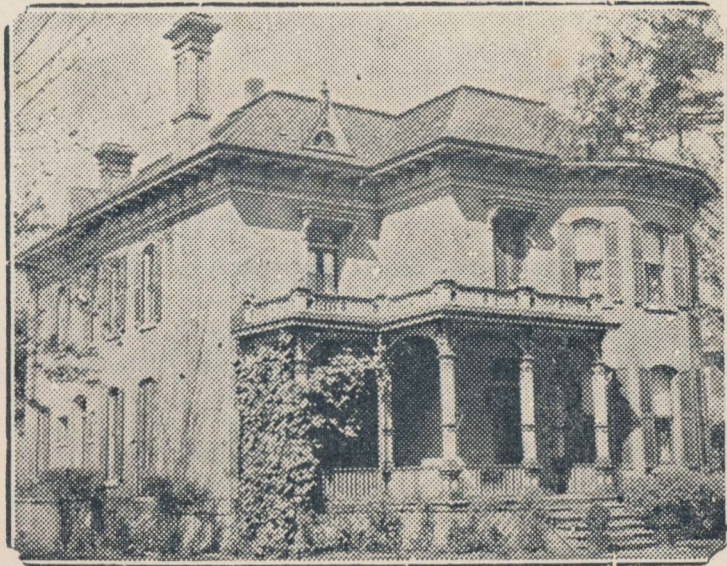

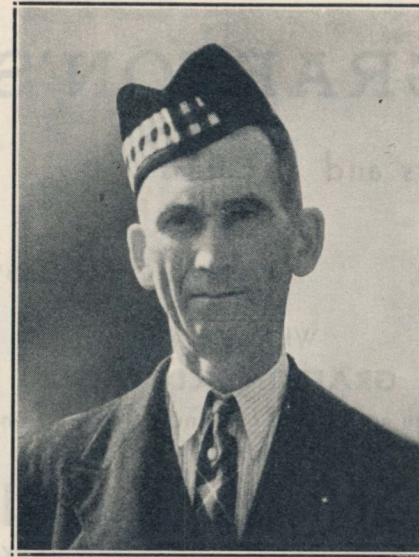

## Dedication and Unveiling of the Cairn

ONE of the great events in the History of Zorra, took place at the North Embro Cemetery at the Dedication and unveiling of the Cairn in honour of the World Champion Zorra Tug-of-War Team of 1893. Congratulations were extended to the Caledonian Society by the special speakers, the Hon. Donald Sutherland and the Hon. D. M. Sutherland, for their efforts in building the Cairn to do honour to men who in their day, brought fame and glory to Zorra.

The service was largely attended, with the Hon. P. M. Dewan, Mr. A. S. Rennie, M.P., Warden Ken Marshall and Mr. B. C. Parker, contributing to the program. Special Scotch music by the St. Thomas Pipe Band with Pipe Major Wright playing the Lament.

The unveiling of the Cairn was made by Mrs. Alex Clarke, widow of Alex Clarke, a member of the team and Fred Hummason, son of another member of the famous team. Rev. Alexander McLean offered the Dedication prayer, and Rev. R. R. Connor the Benediction, Chas. H. Walker was organist, and Mr. James Martin, an old time Scotch Precentor, leading in song.

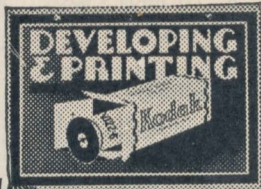

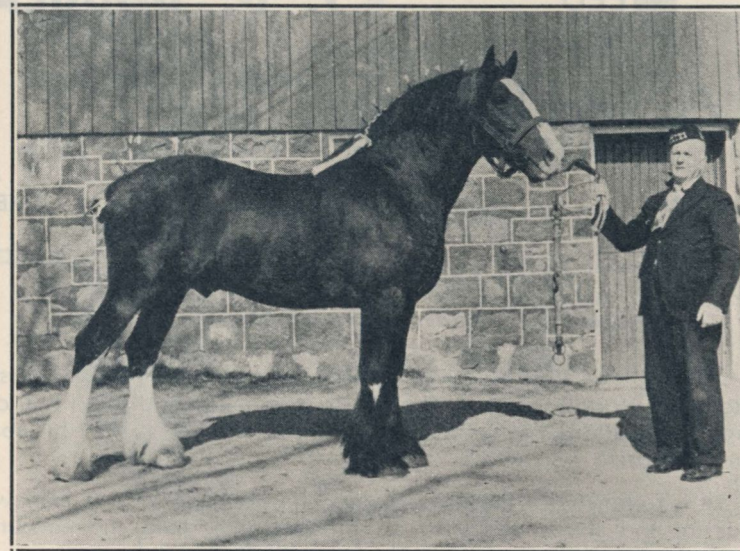

Silent tribute is paid to that immortal host of Zorra sons who paid the last great sacrifice "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends".

As people of Zorra we're proud to honour our King who a little more than a year and a half ago held his coronation when the world listened in, not merely to a passing pageant but to the consecration of a Christian gentleman dedicated to the service of his people and we are proud of the service that he has rendered.

Accordingly here we are to-day members of this great Zorra or inheritors of those traditions that have been handed down to us in a land that even in the times through which we are passing has carried on in a manner that has been the admiration of all.

Surely with all these blessings that are ours we are proud to hail from Zorra and to answer the call that Zorra makes to every one of its sons and daughters in the days that are ahead—men and women of Zorra that have ideals that are lofty and pure, men and women of Zorra that have sympathies for all mankind that are as broad and rich as our own fertile farms: men and women of Zorra that have character as abiding and determined as that of the men and women of old and if we do, then too shall we make for Zorra in the days to come as honorable a place in the history of the world as to-day we hold for it in the days gone by.

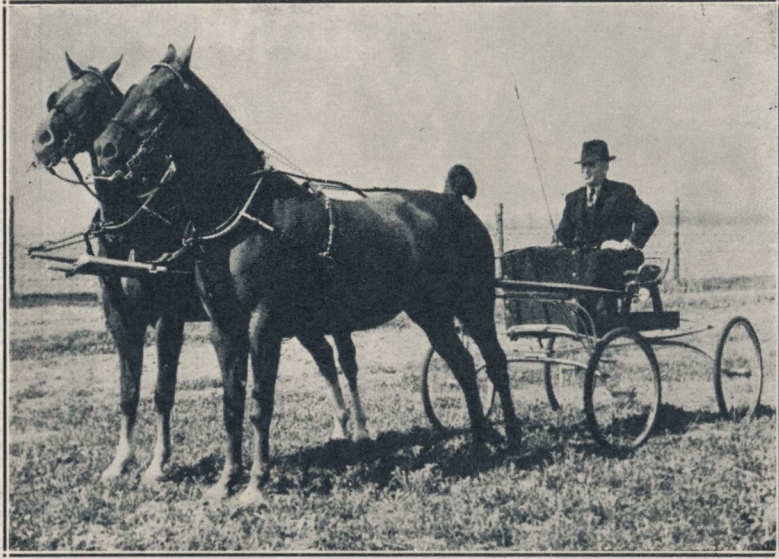

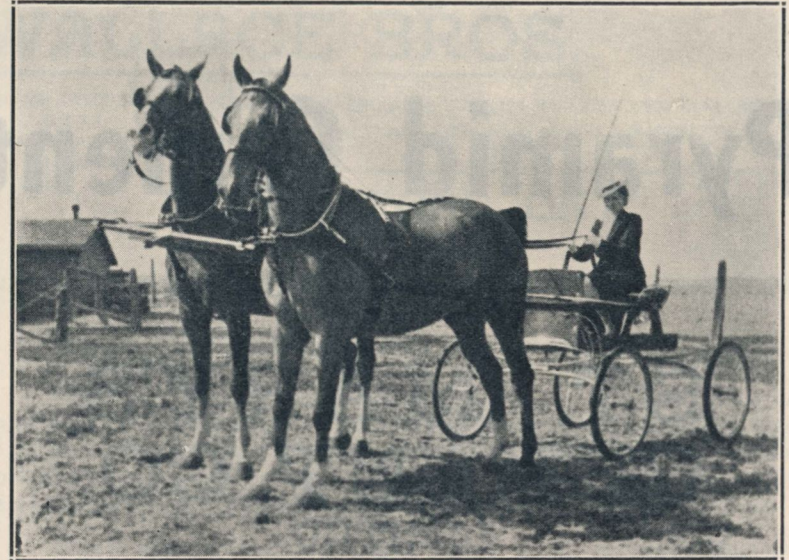

### ZORRA'S HIGHLAND FARM— FAMOUS FOR HACKNEY HORSES

In paying a visit to the Munroe Farm in West Zorra, one is surprised to find a business going enterprise of great importance. The farm has the appearance of one of the old established Country homes, good buildings and solid stone house, possibly one of the finest to be found in the County. The buildings are fully equipped with modern machinery to carry out the work efficiently. The hundred and fifty acres of rolling land is called upon to produce sufficient crops to maintain a heavily stocked farm, consisting of a large variety of farm animals, but the chief interest of the Munroe farm is the horses, which consists at present of 60 head, from the small riding pony to the heavy work horse

The hackney horse that has made the Munroe farm famous, is the chief attraction. The result of the 1938 Canadian National and Royal Winter Fair, brought the Munroe farm 51 major prizes including 2 grand champions.

While the various branches of the stable were called upon to produce this wonderful result, the chief credit must go to the famous mare, Chestnut Smile, 10 year old, known throughout the World as the Grand Champion of Canada. This horse has become so valuable that Mr. Munroe has been forced to refuse well into the four figures as a price to retain this great horse for his own stable.

Gracious Lady, another, 5 year old, has also achieved grand honour as the Reserved Grand Champion and is a close contender of Chestnut Smile. One of Mr. Munroe's favourites is Zorra Boy, a 5 year old, that has been responsible in proving Mr. Munroe's ability to produce Hackney horses. This horse is possibly the spoiled baby of the stable, but the great results it has had in the Show Ring has earned this rich reward.

The Hackney Stallion Lord Nelson, now 9 years old, is a prize animal on the Munroe farm and has many offsprings that may yet prove equal to the Chesnut Smile.

Wallace Munroe is a native of the Zorras in Oxford County and a direct descendant of some of the early Scotch settlers to establish a home in Zorra, located on Crown Land, that has been handed down to the third generation. Born and raised on the farm, Mr. Munroe received his early education at the little Red School House on the 4th line, followed by the practical training on his father's farm. Wallace showed early ability as a specialist in horse culture and breeding. Some few years ago and as quite a young man he commenced to prove his ability by showing winners at local Fall Fairs. This success was soon augmented by exhibiting at larger Fairs. During the past few years his hackney horses have won for him the highest praise of the best authorities in the World.
