

Archibald Barrow was born in Ingersoll on 10 October 1899. to Charles Barrow & Mary Saunders Barrow.



His parents emigrated from England in the 1870s and settled at 201 King Street West, where Charles took up the tailoring trade. The couple eventually had a family of six children.



Archie attended the Central School and after which he began work as a labourer. In January of 1916, he made the brave decision to join the war effort by enlisting at the Ingersoll recruiting office. Archie seems to have lied about his age to meet the minimum enlistment requirment of 18 years. He gives his birth date as 1898 on his Attestation Papers, making his age in compliance.

On enlistment, he joined the 168th Battalion, Oxford Rifles. Archie was sent for training at Camp Francis in London, along with 713 other Battalion members.



On 30 October 1916, Private Archibald Barrow sailed with his unit from Halifax, NS aboard the HMS Lapland, reaching Liverpool, England on 11 November.



Shortly after arrival, the Battalion was transferred & absorbed into the 39th Reserve and in February 1917 they were sent to the field. That field was Vimy Ridge.

"From January 1st, 1917, these men of Oxford reinforced many of the service battalions in France, taking part in all the subsequent operations in which the Canadian corps participated. At Vimy Ridge, at Hill 70, at Passchendaele, at Amiens, at the Second Battle of Arras, at Cambrai, Valenciennes and, finally, at Mons, they fought and fell; and wherever they went it was said of them that their efficiency as fighting men was second to none and that their record was one of which they might justly be proud."

Private Archibald Barrow was killed in action during the attack on Vimy Ridge on 9 April 1917, he was the first of man of 168th Oxford's Own to make the supreme sacrifice.

KILLED IN ACTION.

Pte. Archie Barrow Made Supreme Sacrifice on April 9th.

That her son Pte. Archie Barrow had been killed in action on April the 9th was the sad news which was ceived officially by Mrs. Mary Barrow, King street west, on Friday, Pte. Barrow-is-the-first-Ingersoll-member of the 168th Battalion to give his life," for his king and country. No particudars were given other than the date of his death. Pte. Barrow was one of the younger members of the 168th Battalion. He had resided in Ingersoll all his life up to the time of his enlistment. He was just old enough to be accepted at the time of his enlistment. He was well and favorably known to the young people of the town and the deepest sympathy will be extended to the bereaved mother.


