The Petition of Lenadar Barnes of the

That your Petitioner on the 28<sup>th</sup> June 1794  
was ordered by His Excellency L<sup>t</sup> Governor Simcoe  
in Council 300 acres of Land, and that  
on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1797, your Petitioner was granted  
the L<sup>t</sup> number Eight in front, in the Township  
of Oxford, upon the River Thames, as a Sittler  
under the Township Report, which L<sup>t</sup> contains  
238 acres; and <sup>which</sup> he has obtained the Patent —

That the residue of the 300 acres granted him  
in 1794, has not been located; your Petitioner  
therefore humbly prays your Excellency would  
be pleased to allow him to locate and to receive
