Yeoman

Humbly Sheweth

That your Petitioner obtained a
grant of the Waste Lands of the Crown
on the 8th of July 1806 as a Military Claimant
for his Services during the Revolutionary
War in the Queens Rangers and when
your Petitioner applied to locate
he was told by the late Thomas Bidout
then Surveyor General, that the lands
in the Township of Trafalgar were
all taken up that was good, but three
remained three lots which were broken
and considered bad, (which was the
Case) and that if your Petitioner
would take the said lots for his
grant as he wished to settle there, that
he should have them, and your
Petitioner did accordingly accept
of the offer made to him and went
and settled upon the land and
has always supposed that he had
a title for the three lots as he always
held the Deeds that Mr Bidout gave
him, and which are now heretofore
annexed, and has always considered
the lands as belonging to him until
your Petitioner seen a part of one of

the lots advertised. Which caused
your Petitioner to see after his title
and on Enquiry he was informed
that one Hundred acres of the land
had been disposed of. Your Petitioner
therefore prays that he may be allowed
an other hundred acres of land or that
he may be allowed a remuneration
for the said land, and your
Petitioner as in duty Bound
Will Ever pray
