Loring of William Millcock's land - has by the office
of Peter Loring purchased of James Post his right of
application some time past for the Lot herein mentioned

Your Petitioner respectfully asks
that a Lease may be granted to him for Lot Number
thirteen in the fourth Concession of said Township
bearing date the first Day of the month called May in
the year 1815

Loring of said Town, to pay the amount from the above
mentioned date - as required by the regulation of the

unto our said Lord the King his heirs and Successors - for
which payment to be well and truly made we bind our
selves, respectively, our, and each of our Heirs Executors
and Administrators firmly by these presents, sealed with
our Seals and Dated the first Day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fiftie and
in the fifty fifth year of his Majesties Reign 1815

The Condition of this Obligation is such that
if the above bounden Benjamin Birdall Samuel Colwell
& Peter Loring shall pay the Rent for Lot number
thirteen in the fourth Concession of said Township of
Norwich in the County and district aforesaid being part
of the Land reserved for the Crown - at the Days and
times when they shall become Due, and shall perform
all the Covenants and agreements specified in a certain
Lease from his Majesty for the said Lot of Land to the said
Benjamin Birdall then this Obligation to be void other
wise to remain in full force and effect
