Woodstock August 1<sup>st</sup> 1849

Sir

According to the request of Mr Thomas Woodcock  
I have made a survey of Lot No 9 Con 13 Township of  
Blandford and forward you the requisite plan and  
certificate -

The Lot is of good quality timbered with Beech & Maple  
with the exception of probably 12 acres of Swaly land which  
has the advantage of being timbered with rail timber  
white ash & oak with some black ash. In the present  
state of the Roads access to the Lot is very difficult and  
will be so for a length of time on account of the  
extensive swamps on the south - There are about  
20 acres improved & a log house - The Lot contains  
One hundred and sixty seven acres three rods and  
seven perches - and I should estimate its value  
at fifteen shillings per acre
