and served in that Province from 25 July 1814 to 31 July 1815

That he has resided in this Province from that  
period to the present day being five years

That he is desirous of obtaining a grant of land  
therein as a reduced Lieutenant

That he has taken the Oath of Allegiance  
required by law and has never received any land or order for  
land from the Crown

Wherefore your Petitioner prays that your Excellency  
may be pleased to grant him an allotment of land as a reduced  
Lieutenant of the Corps before mentioned subject to the payment  
of the Patent Fee and to the regulations relative to Military Grants

And as in duty bound he will ever pray
