15th June 1855 approved
by His Excellency the Governor General in
Council on the 15th June 1855.

On a letter from the Commissioner
Crown Lands, dated 25th ultimo, stating
that a Patent having issued in error granting
the North half of Lot N^o 4 in the 12th Con-
cession of Blainford to John Raines instead
of John Burns, it becomes necessary to obtain
the sanction of the Government for the can-
celling of it, under the provisions of the 18th
section of the Land Act, in order that
an amended Patent may issue to the
said John Burns, to whom the land was
sold as the Occupant of it.

Whereas John Barnes, of the Township of Blandford, in the County of Oxford, a Roman



hath contracted and agreed for the absolute purchase of the Lands and Tenements hereinafter mentioned and described, and whereof We are seized in right of Our Crown, and which We have directed should be set apart and appropriated for the Maintenance of Education, at and for the price or sum of

Our said Province, by him the said sixty two pounds, ten shillings of lawful money of

well and truly paid to Our use, at or before the sealing of these Our Letters Patent, We have granted, sold, aliened, conveyed and assured, and by these Presents do grant, sell, alien, convey and assure, unto the said John Barnes of Our said

his heirs and assigns for ever, all that Parcel or Tract of Land, situate, lying and being in the Township of Blandford in the Oxford of Our said Province, containing by admeasurement one hundred acres be the same more or less; which said Parcel or Tract of Land may be otherwise known as

follows, that is to say: being composed of the North half of Lot Number Four in the Twelfth Concession, in the aforesaid Township of Blandford

GIVEN under the Great Seal of Our Province of Canada: Witness, Our Trusty and Well-Beloved SIR EDMUND WALKER HEAD, BARONET, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and the Island of Prince Edward and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c. At QUEBEC, this first day of March in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty five and in the eighteenth year of Our Reign.
