That she employed George Bowman and Joseph Suggs to perform the Settlement duties thereon for the sum of ten pounds which she paid them and received a certificate of said settlement duties being duly performed under the hand of Thomas Flower Esquire Justice of Peace.

That your petitioner has understood that upon inspection of the said land it appeared that the said settlement duties have not been performed which creates a difficulty in her receiving a deed for the same.

That your petitioner is infirm subject to fits and without the means of subsisting her self.

She therefore humbly prays that she may receive a deed for the same or may receive such relief
