I George Thomas Crumpback of the Township of Blenheim
in the County of Oxford Being weak in body but of
sound mind and memory do make this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say

My will is that my funeral charges and just debts shall be
paid by my executors hereinafter named the residue of
my estate and property which shall not be required
for the payment of my just debts funeral charges and
expenses attending the execution of this my will and
the administration of my estate I give devise and dispose
thereof as follows that is to say

First I give and bequeath to my Third son George Sydney
Crumpback the South East Quarter of Lot Number Twenty
two in the seventh Concession of the Township of Blenheim
Containing by admeasurement fifty acres of land more or less
for the sole use and benefit of my said son George Sydney
Crumpback his heirs and assigns for ever

Second I give bequeath and devise to my second daughter
the sum of one hundred Dollars to be paid to her
by my son George Sydney in yearly payments of
Twelve Dollars each year so long as she remains
single and unmarried, the residue remaining unpaid
at the time of her marriage if she should get married
at any time before the whole sum is paid shall then be
paid to her in full within six months after her marriage.

Third I will and bequeath to my son George Sydney
Crumpback his heirs and assigns for ever all my
personal estate consisting of cattle horses sheep ploughs.
Drags. and other personal property money notes that may
be on hand after paying my just debts at my decease

Fourth I give and bequeath to my first son James
Crumpback and to my second son Samuel John Crumpback
their heirs and assigns for ever the sum of one hundred
and twelve Dollars and fifty cents each to be paid
to them their heirs and assigns when collected from my
Fathers estate being the amount willed to me my
heirs or assigns by the last will and Testament of my
Father Henry Crumpback late of the Township of
North Dumfries deceased which sum is due or made
payable to me my heirs or assigns within two years after the
Death of my Mother Mary Crumpback

Fifth I give and bequeath to my first Daughter Caroline Matilda Crumpback her heirs and assigns forever Village Lot Number twelve in Block D. in Maitland Fishers Survey in the Village of Dumbro being composed of part of the North East Quarter of Lot Number thirteen in the sixth concession of the said Township of Blenheim containing one fifth of an acre more or less

Sixth I give and bequeath to my fourth son Henry Crumpback the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to be paid to him by my son George Sydney Crumpback when he arrives at the full age of Twenty one years

Seventh My Will is further that my son George Sydney Crumpback shall keep maintain and Educate my son Henry and Nelson Grooms my step son until they arrive at the full age of Twenty one years and to furnish them with Board and Clothing if they wish to remain with him until they arrive at the age of Twenty one years

Eighth - My will is that my wife shall remain with my son George Sydney Crumpback so long as she shall remain my Widow and that she shall have a good and comfortable living so long as she shall remain My Widow and wishes to live with my son or upon the farm I will and bequeath to my son George Sydney and that she shall be provided for in sickness as well as in health

And I do nominate and appoint Samuel T Crumpback And James McCormic both of the Township of Blenheim to be the sole executors of this my last will and Testament
