in the District of *Brock* and Province of Canada, *Solicitor* one  
of the subscribing witnesses to the last Will and Testament of the late *John Cummings*  
of the *Town* of *Woodstock*  
in the District of *Brock* and province aforesaid *Yorman*  
Deceased, do swear that you were personally present and did see the said *John Cummings*  
sign, seal, publish and declare the *paper Writing*  
now shown to you as he is last Will and Testament; and you the said *William Lapentine*  
do further swear that the names *F. W. Keast*  
which appear as Witnesses to the last Will and Testa-  
ment of the said *John Cummings* are the proper handwriting of them the said  
*F. W. Keast*  
who together with you  
signed ~~the~~ names in the presence of the said testator and at his special instance and  
request, and you likewise further swear that you verily believe that the said  
*John Cummings* at the signing of the said last Will and Testament was of  
sound mind, memory and understanding.

This is the last Will and Testament of me John Cummings of the Town of Woodstock in the District of Brock in the Province of Canada aforesaid. I give and devise unto my wife Ann Cummings for and during her life Lots numbers One and Two in the Eleventh Concession of the Township of Zorra in the County of Oxford in the said District, and from and immediately after her decease I give and devise the same unto my four sons Robert Hughes Cummings, Tom Cummings, Thomas Cummings and Michael Brook Cummings and to them heirs in fee simple, subject however to the charges hereinafter made on the same, equally to be divided between them share and share alike; and in case my said sons or their heirs cannot agree amongst themselves as to the manner in which the same shall be divided or the part each should take for his share I hereby direct that they my said sons or their heirs shall nominate two disinterested competent persons being Farmers to divide the same between them, and in case such two cannot agree about such division I direct that such two Farmers shall nominate some third person being a disinterested Farmer who shall proceed to divide the same amongst my said sons; and such division whether made by the two first chosen, or by the one afterwards chosen shall be final and binding, and the part or share so allotted to each of my said sons or their heirs shall be the share he or they is or are to be entitled to under this my Will as fully and effectually as if I had given such part by name to each of my said sons or their heirs. And Whereas some time since I purchased from Henry Smyth Esquire Lot number twenty five in the twelfth Concession of the said Township of Zorra with names of three of my said sons namely Robert Hughes Cummings, Tom Cummings and Thomas Cummings

and advanced and paid all of the said purchase money which  
has yet been paid thereon; now it is my desire that of my said  
son Nicholas Brink Cummings shall be minded and desired  
to contribute and pay an equal share of the balance which may  
be due for the said lot to the said Henry Smyth Chambers at the  
time of my decease he shall be intitled to an equal share of the  
said lot number twenty five with my said other sons and that  
the same shall be held by him in fee simple, but should my said  
sons Robert Hughes Cummings John Cummings and Thomas  
Cummings refuse to permit the said Nicholas Brink Cummings to  
acquit either by working on the said lot or otherwise, to pay an equal  
share of the balance due for the said lot then I do hereby direct them  
the said Robert Hughes Cummings John Cummings and Thomas Cummings  
to pay to the said Nicholas Brink Cummings one fourth part of the  
money advanced and to be advanced by me for the payment of the same  
and I do hereby charge the said lots numbers one and two  
which the said Robert Hughes Cummings John Cummings and  
Thomas Cummings may be intitled to, with the payment of the  
same to the said Nicholas Brink Cummings after the decease  
of my said wife Ann Cummings. I do hereby also direct my said  
four sons out of the residue of my personal estate to purchase a  
town lot in the said Town of Woodstock in fee simple, and thereon to  
erect three separate and distinct dwelling houses of frame of the  
following dimensions namely eighteen feet wide by twenty four  
feet in length of one story in height, and to have two bed rooms and a  
litting room in each and a small cellar under each house, and  
when built and finished in a proper manner I hereby direct my  
said sons to execute a deed of conveyance in fee simple to each of my  
said daughters of a dwelling house and a third of the said sum-

lot and in case my said residue shall be insufficient for the erection of the said houses and the purchase of the said lot, I do in that event hereby charge my said lots to numbers one and two with the deficiency, or the whole in case there shall be no residue, after the decease of my said wife, but if the residue of my said personal Estate shall be sufficient then I direct the said Dwelling houses to be erected and conveyed as aforesaid to my said daughter within three years next after my decease - I also give and bequeath unto my said wife all the live and dead stock on my said lots numbers one and two and all my household furniture. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my said wife Executive and my said sons executors of this my will. All the residue and remainder of my personal estate after payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses and the erection of the said Dwelling houses and the purchase of the said other lot I give and bequeath unto my said sons in equal shares. And I do hereby revoke all former Wills and Codicils heretofore by me at any time made and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three.
