decease and as to my worldly estate, wherewith it hath  
pleased God to bless me, I give and dispose of the same  
as follows: I give and devise to my beloved wife Jane Davidson  
my house and all my household goods and furniture cattle  
sheep and all my moveable property during her natural  
life or as long as she remains my widow and I give and  
devise to my second son Andrew Davidson the homestead  
and farm wherupon I now reside being Lot No four in  
the first concession of North Oxford to hold to him his  
heirs and assigns for ever, subject nevertheless to the above  
mentioned devise of my house to my wife, and subject also  
to the maintenance and support of my wife and my three  
youngest children both in food and clothing and other  
things that are necessary for their comfort as long as she  
remains my widow or the children my care and protection  
and I give and bequeath my said house and household goods  
and furniture cattle sheep and all my moveable property  
on the decease of my wife (or in the event of her second  
marriage) as also all the rest, residue and remainder  
of my personal estate which may remain in the hands  
of my executor after payments of debts, legacies, funeral  
and executorial expenses, and other charges thereon  
as aforesaid unto my above son Andrew Davidson his heirs

and assigns And I nominate and appoint my  
trusty friend William Withers and my beloved son  
William Davidson to be the executors of this my  
will hereby revoking all former wills In witness  
whereof I the said James Davidson have hereunto set  
my hand and seal the eight day of April in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and forty six
