The Petition of Josiah F. Dean

That your Petitioner has lately arrived in this Province, with an intention to settle therein, that he has brought Cattle, and in order to provide a residence for his Family (which he expects within three months) he has leased a piece of Land, of which he has plowed and planted about six acres - that your Petitioner is well known to Mr. Horner of Blenheim, and is desirous to occupy a Lot in that Township, he therefore prays your Honor for an appropriation of Lot nine on Dundas Street, to be confirmed when your Honor shall judge proper, under the new Regulations, and your Petitioner as on duty bound will ever pray
