The Last Will and Testament of James Dennis of the Township of Norwick north
in the County of Oxford Canada west, feeling the uncertainty of this mortal life,
and having great reason to bless God for his goodness, and care of me, and after resigning
all into the hand of my said Recuperer. I do hereby make and publish this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say. First, I direct that
the South-east quarter of lot number ten in the seventh concession of East-Bedford be
sold at public or private sale, as soon as practicable, and the proceeds thereof to go towards
paying all my just debts, funeral expences, and so forth, after which I do hereby direct that
my said beloved wife Mary Dennis do have, hold, retain, and enjoy the residue thereof for her use
for ever.

Secondly. I direct give and bequeath unto my beloved wife aforesaid the south-east forty acres
of lot number sixteen in the second concession of the Township of Norwick north aforesaid with and
singular the hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also the East
thirty acres of the south half of lot number eighteen in the said second Concession of Norwick aforesaid,
with all and singular as aforesaid unto her use, profit and maintenance during her
life time, and if the my said wife shall after my decease, in fit case to marry again, and have issue
of her body, then I direct give, and bequeath the above mentioned lots of land and hereditaments to her
and to her heirs and assigns for ever, and if at her death she should leave no issue or heirs of her
body as aforesaid, then I direct my executors to divide, or sell and divide the proceeds of such sale of
the above mentioned lots of land, between her relatives or kindred as they my executors shall in fit

Thirdly. I direct that my said wife do have and retain to her use, such of my personal, household furniture
as she may need, and others to have and retain, and the residue together with the farming utensils, live
stock, grain, books, Wagons etc, to be sold at public or private sale as my said executors shall
see fit, and out of said proceeds I further direct that Marshal Faubher be paid the sum
of Two hundred dollars in cloathing, and such other necessaries as may be required for
his maintenance from time to time as he may stand in need thereof.

Fourthly. I direct give and bequeath the next seventy acres of lot number eighteen in
the second concession of Norwick north aforesaid to be let out at a yearly rent so as to im-
prove said farm, and when there is a profit arising from it, the said profit and profits
to go and be for the use, and support of the Second Regular Baptist Church in
Norwick aforesaid, of which I am a member, the said bequest to be under the care and
management of the Trustees of the said Baptist Church from time to time appointed for ever.

Fifthly I do hereby authorise and empower my herein named Executors to bring in account and returning, with demand, collect, sue for, or otherwise as you fit, all debts, or matters or things due unto me, or which may be hereafter due, from all persons, or persons, whomsoever, and to give, and receive all receipts, releases, make and receive deeds of conveyance, and so forth to the best of their means, the same as if they were their own according to the true intent and meaning thereof.

Lasty I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary Dennis as aforesaid my Executrix, and Henry Dennis my beloved brother of Norwicht aforesaid and John Corbin of Norwicht aforesaid and Stephen Stevens of Norwicht aforesaid my Executors to this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other wills by me previously made.
