Sheweth

That your petitioner sometime in the year 1806 established
his claim before the Comtee as the son of John Fife an U. S. L.
to his Majesty's bounty of 200 acres of land.

That your petitioner served as sergeant in the 5th Lincoln
Regt Militia during the late American War and was at the
Battle of Sunday's Lane, and now holds an ensign's commission
in the militia signed by Sir P. Skelton

That Lot No 8 in the 7th Con. of Oxford Co. formerly
located by Joseph Rowley has many years past been vacant
and abandoned by him and your petitioner has been informed
that said Rowley quitted the province many years ago
and enlisted in the United State Army

Your petitioner therefore humbly prays that your
Excellency will be pleased to allow him to locate the said
lot which is situate near to the land upon which
your petitioner resides at Brantford it being your petitioner's
full intention to keep the said lot to which he prays
to be located in his family and not to dispose thereof
