In the Name of God Amen
I Robert Foster of the Township of Blenheim in the County of Oxford and Province of Canada do hereby
calling into mind the shortness of this mortal
life, and being very sick at the present time, but
having the recollection of a sound and disposing mind
memory and judgment, thanks be to Almighty God for
the same: do make and publish this my last
Will and Testament, in manner and form follo-
wing, that is to say,

1st I Will that as soon as convenient, after my decease
all my just and lawful debts be paid.

2nd I Will that my beloved wife Catherine have
one third of the proceeds of all my Real and per-
sonal Estate to do with as she shall please.

3rd I Will that my beloved wife Catherine Foster
be and she shall constitute and appoint for my
sole Executrix to this my last Will and Testament
with full powers to make do and execute, all and
Singulars and papers as may be necessary for the
discharge of her office as my Executrix, and also to
make such partition or divisions of my estate
both Real and personal, among my Children as she
may in justice deem meet,

And lastly revoking all and every other Will or
Will Testament or Testament, Legacies Bequests or
Executors by me in anywise hitherto appointed or
published I declare this to be my last Will and
Testament I Witness whereof I have hereunto my seal
and subscribed my name at Blenheim this fourth
day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty seven.
