Sir,
Lot No. 6 in the 4th Con^{ty} of Blandford was purchased
by John Fowell in March 1847 and one instalment
paid. and the said John Fowell informed me
three or four years since when asking him for pay-
ment, that he did not intend to make further pay-
ments until he was forced to do so this I have already
represented to the Department

I have lately been informed by reliable
information that he has built a lumbering shanty on
the lot for the purpose of plundering it of its timber
which is its principal value as the soil is of an inferior
quality - as for his paying for the lot I am satisfied
he will never be able or willing to do so so that the
sooner the lot is resumed by the Department and resold
the better. At present while the lot retains the
most of its timber it would bring I think from five
to six dollars per acre
