I commit my soul to Almighty God in hope of a joyful resurrection and that my body be decently interred after my decease, and that all my honest Debts be paid. That I Will and Bequeath to my Wife Susanna Jenter thirty one Acres of Land and a Frame House situate in the Township of Chatham County Long Point District Upper Canada during the Term of her life and after her decease the Property to be sold and equally divided amongst my Children James Jenter Daniel Jenter Lydia Jenter Emily Jenter secondly I Will that my son James shall be my whole and sole Executor of my Wishes and Personal Property Goods and Chattels situate in the Township of Durham District of York Upper Canada consisting of 95 Acres of Land on the South half of Lot No 5 in the 8 Range more or less in the said Township. That I Will that the said James Jenter Executor shall divide said Property Wishes and Personal Property equally among his Mother Daniel Jenter Lydia Jenter Emily Jenter and himself. I Will
