deceased, ^{to} make or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular, the goods, chattels, and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come into the hands, possession or knowledge of *her* the said *Ann Sophia Fuzell*

or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for *her* and the same so made, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited in to the registry of *the Superior Court*, on or before the *last Monday in March* ~~day of her next~~ ^{ensuing}, and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all and other the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, at the time of *his* death, which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of the said *Ann Sophia Fuzell*
