Oct. 15-20 W. Clifford was leased in 1824 to Freedom  
Mason & George Nichol - who at the expiration of the lease  
in 1825 had only paid £9-15 for rent, leaving due £15-5  
Since 1825 the rent amounts to £34-16-8, making the  
total £50-1-8 - The original leases were regularly  
notified respecting the rent in 1823, to which no attention  
has been paid, and as no improvements whatever  
have been made on the lot, they to recommend  
that a lease be granted to the petitioner, who  
intends to become an actual settler, and who has  
paid up the back rent in full - £50-1-8
