To His Excellency Sir Francis Head  
Lieutenant Governor of Upper Canada.

The Petition of Rothwell Garnett of  
the Township of North Oxford London District U.C. Humbly  
Sheweth

That Lot No. 15 in the third concession of  
North Oxford a Cleary reserve was some years back leased to  
George Neal and another. That said lease has now been expired  
several years. and said Neal owes a large amount of rent.  
That your petitioner being desirous to obtain said lot applied to  
purchase it and was informed that in the first instance it was  
required that he should pay the amount of rent due on the Lot amounting  
to the sum of Fifty pounds one shilling & 8 Cts. and that the same  
should be valued; this was done by Mr Canal Sec for Surveying - at  
4 1/2 dollars per acre. and the Hon<sup>ble</sup>. Peter Robinson agreed with  
petitioner to sell him the Lot at 4 dollars per acre. reducing it one half  
dollar per acre in consideration of the large amount which petitioner  
paid down. No improvement or station had been made on the land  
by the Neal or the other party. Petitioner having memorialized the Council
