Know all Men by these presents that John Gillam, Joshua Gillam and Andrew Cohoe of the Township of Norwich in the County of Oxford and District of London, are held and jointly bound, unto our Sovereign Lord the King, his Heirs or Successors, in the Sum of Twenty Pounds Lawful Money of this Province, to be paid unto our said Lord the King his Heirs or Successors, for which payment to be well and truly made, we bind ourselves respectively, our and each of our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly by these presents, sealed with our Seals, Dated this twenty fourth Day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and eighteenth and in the fifty year of his Majesty's Reign

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden John Gillam, Joshua Gillam and Andrew Cohoe shall pay the Rent for Lot Number Six in the second concession of the Township of Norwich in the County and district aforesaid, being part of the Land reserved for the Crown at the Days and times when they become Due, and shall perform all the Covenants and agreements, specified in a certain Lease from his Majesty for the said Lot of Land, to the said John Gillam then this Obligation to be void, otherwise in full force and effect
