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I Wilson Hackett of the Township of Bershaw in the County of Oxford and Province of Canada, Heretofore being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made.

First. I hereby constitute and appoint Adam Gripp and Ebenezer Rodwell of the Township of Bershaw in the County of Oxford, Heretofore, being Executors of this my last Will and Testament, directing my said Executors to pay all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses as soon as conveniently may be after my decease, and the cleared amount hereafter said out of my Estate and effects.

Second. I give and bequeath unto George Marcus of the Village of Ingersoll in the County of Oxford, Carpenter, John Gaud of the Township of Bershaw in the said County, Stone Mason, and John Brown of the Village of Ingersoll aforesaid, Gentlemen, Trustees of the Baptist Church of Ingersoll, and their Successors, the Sum of Five Hundred Dollars upon Trust that the said George Marcus, John Gaud and John Brown and their Successors as trustees as aforesaid, should invest the same in some good and safe funds in the Province of Canada, and collect the interest arising therefrom annually or more frequently if it should so become due, and pay the said interest as soon as collected as aforesaid to the Pastor of the said Baptist Church of Ingersoll aforesaid.

Third. After payment of the debts and Sums aforesaid I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Peter Utter the Sum of Five Hundred Dollars if he is living at the time of my death, but if he be dead at that time, then I give and bequeath unto my Nephews Leroy Utter and Charles Utter the said Sum of Five Hundred Dollars in Equal Parts.

Fourth. After payment of the debts and Sums aforesaid I give and bequeath unto my said Nephews Leroy Utter and Charles Utter the residue of my Estate whether real or personal to be equally divided between them.

Fifth. I hereby direct and request that my said Executors shall collect what is due to me on Mortgages and Notes as soon as conveniently may be after my death when such collection will not distress the Parties but when such collection of the whole would distress the Parties and they should be able to pay part then I direct and request that my said Executors shall collect one third of the amount due annually on the said Parties paying at the rate of ten per cent per annum on the unpaid principal, and when such collection of part would distress the Parties then I direct and request that my said Executors shall give the said Parties two or three Years to meet their payments or then paying at the rate of ten per cent per annum for the amounts respectively held by them, and

Furthermore I hereby direct and request that my said Executors shall pay over to the parties entitled thereto the moneys arising from the said Mortgage and note as soon as collected, and that my said Executors shall divide equally between my said nephew the said County of them at the time of each payment.
