do make publish and declare this my
last will and testament

My will is first that all my just
debts be paid the expenses incurred in
and about my funeral and all expenses
which may be incurred in and about
this my last will and testament

My will is that there be reserved
out of my Chattle property ^{as follows} the whole
of my household property two Cows, one
three or four Wagon and harness which prop-
erty I give and bequeath to my dearly
beloved wife Sarah for the use of her
my wife her heirs Executors administrators
and assigns for ever

It is my will that so soon as
may be considered expedient by my Executors
hereinafter appointed that all my Chattle
property (except the articles above enumerated) be
sold as also my real estate situated
in the village of Embury and that the proceeds
arising from such sales be applied towards the
payment of my debts as aforementioned and
any residue arising from such sales be applied
towards the payment of the amount due upon
the Mortgage held by Peter McKay against my
farm in Westford being the West half of lot
number twelve in the Seventh concession in
said Township

My will is that all and every
of the profits rents and monies which in any
way ^{will} arise or be derived from my said farm
be applied towards the payment of the above
mentioned mortgage

My will is that after paying

shortly ago has been paid and satisfied that
then my Executors shall annually and as
often as the rents and profits ^{are} derived from
said farm invest the same in such
securities as shall appear to them best
and in such a manner as shall enable
them to pay over to Sophia Burdick daughter
of James Burdick Decedent the sum of
five hundred dollars, it being understood
that this is the \$500⁰⁰ mentioned in the
will of the said said James Burdick and
for which I am responsible for the payments
of under an agreement entered into between
me and Saphrona Burdick his wife - and
the balance of such rents and profits it
is my pleasure shall go to my wife Anna
for her and my families behoof and benefit

My will is further that my
said farm be equally divided between my
two sons their heirs Executors administrators
and assigns for ever - but should either of them
die before coming of age then my will is
that it go to the survivor whom he may
be, subject however to the following proviso
that should the whole of the above sum of
five hundred dollars not be paid by the time
that they come of age that then the said sum
of money shall become and is hereby declared
to be a lien upon my said farm N^o 12
1/2 - 7 Con West Gonna.

It is my will that my two
dear friends William Harrington and James
Carster of East Gonna Maine be Executors
along with my dear beloved wife Saphrona
for the carrying out of the several clauses
of this my last will and testament.
