and discharged by my Executors, hereinafter
named forth and out of my personal Estate
so soon after my decease as possible. And
I give and bequeath unto my well beloved
Wife Hannah Hammer Fifty Acres of land,
being the North half of number Three in the
Ninth Concession of Burford, also I bequeath
unto my said wife all my Household and
loose property which may be left after the
payment of all my just debts funeral expences
&c, - I also bequeath unto my well beloved
son David Gilbert Hammer his Heirs Executors
Administrators and Assigns that parcel or tract
of land being the North west angle of Lot
number eight in the Ninth Concession of Burford
containing Thirty acres, and should the said
David Gilbert die before he arrives at the
age of twenty one Years, then the said property
herein mentioned say Thirty Acres of land
to become the sole property of my wife Hannah
Hammer, after which said death as to the rest
the residue and remainder of my personal Estate
Goods and Chattels of what kind and nature

whatsoever, I give and bequeath the same
to my said beloved Wife Hannah Hammer
whom I hereby appoint my executrix of this
my last will and Testament, And I further
more appoint Russel Smith and George
Smith of Barford Executors jointly to this
my last will and Testament. In Witness
whereof I the said David G Hammer the Testator
have to this my last will and Testament
set my hand and seal this Twentieth ninth
day of November in the Year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight Hundred and forty one.
