 have been near two years in the Province, &

 your Honor would be pleased to grant him  
 1200 Acres, as the original Petitioner for the  
 appropriation of Oxford — and that his family  
 may be indulged with a grant of Lands  
 and as in Duty bound your Petitioner will  
 ever pray —
