of the Township of Dercum, in the County of
Offord and Province of Canada, being of
sound mind and memory, do make, publish
and declare this my last will and Testa-
ment, in Manner following; that is to say:
- Subject to the payment of all my just debts
and Funeral expenses.

First I give, devise and
bequeath to Sophia Rogers formerly wife
of John Rogers of the City of Hamilton, ~~who~~
Sophia James my present beloved wife all
my Real and personal Estate whatsoever and
wherever of which I am now possessed:
together with all chattles now or hereafter
to the estate are the following conditions:

That is to say; that she is to own
and use for her own, and the children's benefit
and support, all the property here devised and
bequeathed as long as she remains a widow;
and my six children are to have a home and
a support on the estate as long as they
require it, or remain unmarried: But in
case she ceases to be my widow and marries

Then during the remaining period of her natural life she is to have one third of the income of Estate in money or produce as she may require for her dinner. At the period of her marriage if such an event should take place before the termination of her natural life it is my will that the children shall possess my whole property but I accordingly devise and bequeath to them at the above period ^{by her marriage or death} all my real estate as well as personal, to them Mary Ellen James my oldest daughter, Jane James my second daughter, Frances Amelia James my third daughter, Sarah James my fourth daughter, Sophia James my fifth daughter, and Isobel Victoria my youngest daughter and child: To them their heirs ad eⁿ tibiis forever. I further desire that when my youngest daughter attains the age of Twenty-one my executors sell the estate and divide it equally among the six children above named and if any of them should die before the period referred to the whole to be equally divided among the surviving children, and the portion set apart for their mother's dinner, if she shall be then alive. I further desire that as each of my daughters attains the age of Twenty-one, or Marries; they shall each have a

decent and suitable as if it; the value
of which to be afterwards deducted from
their share when the property is sold and
divided; so that each will have an
equal proportion of the whole.

Lastly I appoint John Gregg Senior of the
Township of Donham County of Oxford, and
Province of Canada Gentleman, and James
Denton of the same Township, County and
Province above said my sole Executors; and
my wife Sophia James my sole Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, hereby
devolving all former Wills made by me.
