infant son of the late John Ham late of the Township of
West Oxford in the County of Oxford Yeoman deceased
unto his next sum of five hundred pounds
— of lawful money of England to be
paid to the said Freeman Ham or his certain attorney
executors administrators or assigns for which payment
well and truly to be made We bind ourselves and each of
us our and each of our heirs executors and administrators
and every of them jointly and severally firmly by these
presents sealed with our Seals. Dated this twenty ninth
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty six.

Whereas the above Comedian Gilbert Duncan has this day been
appointed the Guardian of the person and property of the said Freeman
Ham by William Lapenther Esquire the Judge of the Surrogate
Court of the County of Oxford. and the said ^{Gilbert Duncan} hath as he is required by law
to do agreed to give security to the said Freeman Ham for the due &
discharge of his duties as such Guardian. Now the condition of the
above written Bond or obligation is such that if the said Gilbert Duncan
do and shall faithfully perform the trust reposed in him as such Guardian
and that he the said Gilbert Duncan his executors or administrators
will when the said Freeman Ham shall become of the full age of
twenty one years and whensoever the said Guardianship shall be determined
or sooner if he be required by the Judge of the said Court render to the said
Freeman Ham or to his executors or administrators a true and just
account of all goods monies interest rents profits or property of the said
Freeman Ham which shall have come into the hands of the said
