Kelly by William Laprotiere Esquire
Judge of the Surrogate Court of the County of
Oxford and the said Mary Carney has as
she is required by Law to do agreed to give
security to the said Infant Children aforesaid
for the due discharge of her duties as such
Guardian.

Now the Condition of the foregoing

Bond or obligation is such that if the said
Mary Carney do and shall faithfully perform
the trusts reposed in her as such Guardian
and that if the said Mary Carney her Executors
or administrators do and shall when the said
Infant Children shall respectively attain the
age of twenty one years or whenever the said
Guardianship shall be determined or sooner
if thereto required by the Judge of the said
Court render to the said Infant Children
