# IN THE SURROGATE COURT.

*William Lapointe*

*County of Oxford*

To the next of Kin of the Late *Edward Kennedy* of the Township of Oakland  
in the District of County of Oxford Deceased.

Whereas, *Sandford Benedict King* of Oakland aforesaid Intestate  
exhibited a petition in the said Court, setting forth, that the said *Edward Kennedy*  
died in or about the month of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty  
intestate, at the Township of Oakland aforesaid

that Letters of Administration to the Estate of the said Deceased hath not been granted, as he believes, that the said *Edward Kennedy* at the time of his decease was possessed of divers Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits; that the said *Sandford Benedict King* is a Creditor to the estate of the said *Edward Kennedy* to the amount of six pounds twelve shillings and four pence, on a Judgment obtained against the said *Edward Kennedy* in Surrogate Court Number Two in the County of Oxford.

And that he is desirous that an administrator should be appointed to the said Intestate Estate. Petitioner therefore prayed that Letters of Administration to the intestate estate of the said *Edward Kennedy* might be granted to him in default of Administration being taken out by the next of Kin to the said *Edward Kennedy* deceased.

Now Therefore these are to cite and require you the next of Kin to the said *Edward Kennedy* County of Oxford to be and appear in the said Surrogate Court to be held in the Town of Woodstock, in the said District of Brock, and Province of Canada, on the first Monday in January next ensuing the date hereof, then and there to shew cause if any you have, why Letters of Administration of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of the said *Edward Kennedy* at the time of his death, should not be granted to the said *Sandford Benedict King*.
