in Council of the 1st of August 1797 - and that he
has paid the Surveying and Patent Fee for the same
under the Regulations of the 9th July 1796 -

That applying at the Council Office for the order
in Council, your Petitioner is there informed, that
the order was only an appropriation of 200 acres
of land in your Petitioner's name for Twelve months
(a Term of Time then required to convince the applicants
residence) - That your Petitioner has resided
in the Township of Oxford ever since the year 1797
and has a family consisting of a wife and

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Five children; He therefore most humbly
prays your Excellency would be pleased to
confirm the before mentioned order in Council
and to authorize the issuing of a Patent in his name
for the before mentioned Lot of Land, under the
Regulations acted upon the 9 July 1796,
