herein after mentioned. Item, first I leave &  
bequeath to my sons Isaac Kipp, Benjamin Kipp  
Richard Kipp, David Kipp, & Daniel Kipp and  
John Kipp the sum of five shillings each  
and to my beloved wife Hannah all my beds and  
bedding, and household furniture and the house  
and farm on which we now reside to be and remain  
for her own use for and during her natural  
life, excepting thereon of and there from one feather  
bed and bedding which I do leave and bequeath to my  
grand daughter Hannah Reece, and to my  
daughter Eliza Reece the sum five shillings and  
four pence of pence to be delivered to her every  
year for six years after my decease to be given  
by my executors or some one of them on her own  
receipt only on every first day of January for  
six years after my decease, and all remainder  
of my worldly goods wheresoever and whatsoever  
I do leave and bequeath to my wife Hannah for  
excepting thereon a note of hand against Thomas Evans and son to  
her use and a ~~Deed to the severall place by~~  
which I leave to Shuban Lawrence for  
her own use

And I do hereby declare this writing  
to be my last will and testament hereby  
revoking all former wills by me made

and further I do order that out of any money  
that may be in my possession at the time of  
my decease my executors pay all my just debts  
and funeral expenses - and I do hereby  
appoint my wife Hannah Scammon

and John Jackson of the Township of Blen-

Esqur and William Force of the Township

executors of this my last will and testament
