That your petitioner is the son  
of Harmonus Lorraway late of the County of  
the District of Niagara, Taylor, deceased an U  
Loyalist, that he has attained the full age of  
twenty one years and has never received any  
land nor any order for land from the Crown

It therefore your petitioner prays  
that your Excellency may be pleased to  
grant him two hundred acres of the waste  
lands of the Crown as the son of an U  
Loyalist

And your petitioner as in

Henry W Lorraway of the County of  
Oakland in the State of Michigan in the United  
States of America, but now residing at  
Sandwich in the Western District farmer -  
Maketh Oath and saith that he is the person

who was an U E Loyalist and that he this  
deponent has attained the <sup>full</sup> age of twenty one  
years and has never received any land nor  
any order for land from the Crown
