Know all Men by these presents that Peter G Lapsing, Andrew G Lapsing and Samuel Cornwall of the Township of Norwich, in the County of Oxford and District of London are held and firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lord the King, his heirs or Successors in the sum of twenty Pounds, of Lawful money of this Province to be paid unto our said Lord the King his heirs or Successors, for which payment to be well and truly made, we bind ourselves respectively, our and each of our heirs, Executors and administrators firmly by these presents, Sealed with our Seals, and Dated this Twenty fourth Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen, and in the fifty eighth year of his Majesties Reign

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden Peter G Lapsing, Andrew G Lapsing and Samuel Cornwall shall pay the rent for Lot Number Twelve in the fifth Concession of the Township of Norwich, in the County and District aforesaid being part of the Land reserved for the Clergy, at the Days and times when they become due, and shall perform all the Covenants and agreements specified in a certain Lease from his Majesty for the said Lot of Land to the said Peter G Lapsing; then this Obligation to be void, otherwise in full force and effect
