This is the last Will and Testament of me Tracy Ludington of the Township of Blandford
in the County of Oxford, deceased, I hereby give and devise unto my Executors herein-
after named the said half of the North half of Lot Number Seven in the eleventh Concession
of the Township of Blandford aforesaid containing by measurement Fifty acres be the same,
more or less, to hold the same unto and to the use of the said Executors their heirs and assigns.
And I give and bequeath all my goods and chattels from Park money and securities for
many debts and other personal estate and effects of what kind soever unto the said Executors
their Executors administrators and assigns. And I declare that my said real and personal
estate are so devised and bequeathed upon the trusts intents and purposes and subject
to the further proviso and declarations hereinafter expressed and declared of and concerning the
same respectively that is to say upon trust that my said Executors or the Executor for the time being
of this my will do and shall with all convenient speed after my decease call in and convert into
money my said personal estate. And do and shall at such time as they may think it best
to do so, absolutely sell or dispose of my said Land above described by public auction or by
private contract for such price or sum of money as my said Executors or Executor shall
see reasonable and for promoting such sale do and shall enter into make and execute all
such contracts covenants agreements conveyances deeds matters and things which
to them shall seem reasonable. And I declare that the receipt of the said Executors or
Executor for the time being of my will for any money payable under this my will shall
affectionately discharge the person or persons paying the same from being answerable or
accountable for the non application or misapplication thereof or any part thereof or
from being obliged to see to the application thereof or any part thereof or to inquire into the
necessity or propriety of any sale or mortgage that may be made by trustee of this my will and
that no person purchasing my said Land or my part thereof shall be obliged to ascertain or
inquire into the necessity or propriety or uprightness of any such sale. And I declare that the
said Executors or Executor for the time being shall stand and be possessed of and interested
in the money to arise from the sale or sales hereinbefore decided to be made of my said Land
or to arise and be produced from my said personal estate which I have decided to be con-
verted into money and of and in the rents issues and profits thereof until the same shall
be converted into money before to invest the same in such real securities in
Barada as they shall think proper and out of the income arising therefrom to pay and apply
so much thereof as they may think necessary for the maintenance ^{and education} of my children
Warren Gregory Ludington, Tracy Ludington and Allotta Ludington; and to pay to the
said Warren Gregory Ludington and Tracy Ludington whom and as they shall
respectively attain the age of twenty one years one third each of the principal sum

is entitled or that may have accumulated under the provisions hereinafter contained

that if either or any of my said children ^{being sons} shall die before they attain the age of twenty one years

or survivor. And I hereby appoint William Wilson and Joseph B. Elliston both of the
Town of Winsted in the County of Oxford Shoemakers Executors of this my will. And
I appoint my friend Stephen B. Tracy of the Township of East Jordan in the County of Oxford
Guardian of my said children and I hereby revoke all former wills and testaments by
me at any time heretofore made and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
