In the name of God Amen
I Rebecca Maguire of the Township of
Missouri East, County of Oxford, District of
Brock, and Province of Canada West being
weak in body but of sound and perfect
mind and memory, Do make and
constitute this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following.

That is to say; First I give and resign my
soul into the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and my body I commit to
the earth from whence it was taken to be
buried in a plain and decent, manner
and with respect to my personal or world-
ly estate I will and devise first that all
my debts and expenses be discharged;

Next, After the proceeds of a Mortgage I hold
against, My son in law Robert Weston shall
have been paid I will and bequeath to my
Eldest Daughter Rebecca the sum of two
pounds ten shillings lawful currency of this
Province. Next I will and bequeath to
my other Daughter Hannah all the rest and
residue of my effects consisting of all my
household furniture, goods and chattels debts
due to me whether by Notes, Book Accounts
Mortgages, or obligations of whatever nature
or kind belongs to me, to be for her behoof and
benefit. I do hereby revoke all former wills
made by me at any time made whatever, and
lastly I do hereby appoint my two friends
George Chaney Groat and Moses Clark
as the sole Executors of this my last will

and Testament.

sand eight hundred and fifty three

That the said Rebecca Maynard duly made and published her last Will and
Testament in writing bearing date the fourth day of December in the Year of
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifty three, and thereby appointed
Your Petitioners Executors of the said Will, that the said Rebecca Maynard
departed this life at the said Townships of East-Monroie without having in
any way altered or revoked her said Will, on or about the tenth day of
January one thousand Eight hundred and fifty four, that at the time
