Brock, and Province of Canada West being
weak in body but of sound mind perfect
mind and memory; Do make and
constitute this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following
That is to say; First I give and resign my
soul into the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and my body I commit to
the earth from whence it was taken to be
buried in a plain and decent manner
and with respect to my personal or worldly
estate I will and devise first that all
my debts and expenses be discharged,
Next After the proceeds of a Mortgage I hold
against my son in law Robert Weston shall
have been paid I will and bequeath to my
eldest Daughter Rebecca the sum of two
pounds ten shillings lawful currency of this
Province. Next I will and bequeath to
my other Daughter Hannah all the rest and
residue of my effects consisting of all my
furniture goods and chattels debts
due to me whether by Notes; Book Accounts
Mortgages, or obligations of whatever nature
or kind belongs to me to be for her benefit and
benefit. I do hereby revoke all former wills
made by me at any time made whatever, and
lastly I do hereby appoint my two friends
George Sharpe Groth and Moses Clark
as the sole Executors of this my last will

and Testament,
