situate in the Township of Dorchester, in the  
London District — To Wit, Broken Lots, number  
six and seven in the thirteenth Concession  
said to contain two Hundred acres of Land.

and His Majesty's patent was issued to  
your petitioner for the said land, dated the  
second day of February in the Year of our  
Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen.

That in consequence of some mistake in  
the survey of the adjoining Townships, the  
land intended for your petitioner is occupied  
by a man by the name of M. Laughlin,  
and now forms a part of the Township of  
Malahide



The said M. Laughlin refuses to give  
 your petitioners possession of the land originally  
 granted, and decided to her

Your petitioners humbly pray your  
 Excellency will be pleased to direct her claim  
 to be looked into, in order that her family  
 may not be wronged out of the land, she  
 intended as a home for her children, which  
 land has become very valuable.

and as in duty bound your peti-  
 tioners will ever pray.
